Before we start the quiz...what is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a paid job where the apprentice learns and gains valuable experiences. You can undertake an apprenticeship over the age of 16.

Apprentices spend at least 20% of their working hours completing classroom-based learning with a college, university or training provider which leads to a nationally recognised qualification.

An apprenticeship includes:

- paid employment with holiday leave
- hands-on-experience in a sector/role of interest
- at least 20% off-the-job training
- formal assessment which leads to a nationally recognised qualification







You can do an apprenticeship at almost any level of education from Level 2 (the equivalent to GCSE level) right up to Level 7 (Masters degree level).

Apprenticeships can be undertaken in hundreds of industries and thousands of work places.
